Will WE Prepare The Way Of The Lord?

Jeremiah 30:7. Alas! For that day is great, so that none is like it; it is even the time of Jacob's1 trouble but he shall be saved out of it.....v24, in the latter days ye shall consider it.

Revelation 14:6-8, And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

Jeremiah 51:6, Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this is the time of the LORD'S vengeance; he will render unto her a recompence.

Revelation 18:3-4, For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies. And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Revelation 14:8 And [then] there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.

Jeremiah 51:8, Babylon is **suddenly** fallen and destroyed:

Revelation 18:8 Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her.

Jeremiah 50:33, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah were oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

Jeremiah 51:50, Ye that have escaped the sword,³ go away, stand not still: remember the LORD afar off, and let Jerusalem come into your mind.

Jeremiah 51:10,come, and let us declare in Zion the work of the LORD our God.

Jeremiah 31:6-8, 6, For there shall be a day, that the watchmen **upon the mount Ephraim**₄ shall cry₅ Arise ye, and let us go up to Zion₆ unto the LORD our God.₇ 7 For thus saith the LORD; Sing with gladness for Jacob, and **shout among the chief of the nations:**₈ **[USA, UK] publish ye, praise ye, and say,** O LORD, **save thy people, the remnant of Israel.** 8 Behold, I **will** bring them from the north country, and gather them from the coasts of the earth, and with them the blind and the lame, the woman with child and her that travaileth with child together: a great company shall return thither. 9 They **shall** come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I **will** cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim is my firstborn.

Jeremiah 50:28, The voice of those who flee and escape out of the land of Babylon to declare in Zion⁹ the vengeance of the LORD our God, The vengeance of His temple.¹⁰

Isaiah 40:1,3. Comfort ye, comfort ye my people, saith your God. 2 Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her,... 3 The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, <u>Preparen</u> ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

Isaiah 40:6. The voice said, Cry.₁₂ And he said, What shall I cry? 40:9 NIV, **"You who bring good news to Zion**, go up on a high mountain. You who bring good news to Jerusalem, lift up your voice with a shout,₁₃ lift it up, **do not be afraid**; say to the towns of Judah, "Here is your God!" Verse 10, 'Behold, the Lord GOD **will** come with strong hand, and his arm₁₄ **shall** rule for him: behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

Isaiah 43:10. "You are My witnesses," says the LORD, "And My servant whom I have chosen."

Matthew 25:5, While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.

Isaiah 51: 7, 9. Hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings. 9 Awake, awake, put on strength, O arm₁₅ of the LORD; awake, as in the ancient days, in the generations of old.

Isaiah 52:1. "Awake, awake, clothe yourself with strength, O Zion!"¹⁶ Put on your garments of splendour, [God's Law]....7-8, How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion,¹⁷ "Your God reigns!" 8 Listen! Your

watchmen lift up their voices; together they shout for joy. When the LORD returns to Zion, they will see it **with their own eyes**. NIV.

Isaiah 62:6-7. "I have set watchmen¹⁸ upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace day nor night: ye that make mention of the LORD, keep not silence, And give him no rest, till he establish, and **till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth;**

Daniel 11:35. "And some of them of understanding shall fall, to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the time of the end: because it is yet for a time appointed.

Revelation 6:11-12 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled. 12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal....

Daniel 9:27. And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: **and in the midst of the week** he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease....

Daniel 12:3, 7. 'Then the wise₁₉ will shine like the brightness of the heavens, and those who lead many to righteousness will shine like the stars forever and ever. 7 And the man dressed in linen₂₀ who was above the waters of the river, raised his right hand and his left hand toward heaven, and I heard him swear by Him who lives forever, saying, **"It will be for a time, and times, and half a time.** When the power of the holy people has finally been shattered, all these things will be completed." ²¹

References

1. Jacob's. That is, Ephraim's and Manasseh's trouble.

2. Babylon. Those nations who have behaved like Babylon, eg. US and UK, now awaiting God's punishment.

3. The sword. Invasion and captivity after God brings Jacob down, before Christ's return. It will actually be safer for some, in Jerusalem, than their own Israelite nations due to Daniel 9:27, 11:23!

4. Mount Ephraim. UK or her ex-colonies. Judah will be the only country safe from the Beast's invasion during the first 5 Seals.

5. Cry. Cry out! This message of Hope to 'Israel' will be broadcast from Jerusalem by the few faithful who were wise enough to obey and prepare their role long **before** the invasion of Jacob.

6. Zion. Jerusalem

7. To God. Psalm 132:14, "For the LORD hath chosen Zion... This is my rest for ever: here will I dwell; for I have desired it."

8. Chief of the nations. The Israelite nations of the West, then in captivity because of their sins, and in danger of perishing without hope, in their slavery.

9. Zion. Jerusalem, from where the message of Hope and Vengeance will be broadcast.

10. The persecuted Church of God, wherever.

11. We must prepare the way for Christ to return. Of His mercy, He cannot come until we obey His commanded End-Time Commission. Are you prepared to leave for Jerusalem to begin the Broadcast? Of course not. None of the churches have even acknowledged our responsibility to prepare for this major move despite nearly all being contacted and warned.

Revelation 18:8 and 10 reveal the fall of Jacob will be a shock to the world when it occurs. It will be far too late then, to prepare the move to Jerusalem, before WW3 begins at the 2^{nd} Seal!

God's instructions above are, in effect, prophecy, and so they will occur, but only by the faithful few. The vast majority of God's Church will continue to fail to find or even acknowledge God's End-Time instructions and so will likely give their lives in repentance, after the 6th Seal Resurrection, Matthew 25:10, Revelation 7:14, Revelation 12:17, Revelation 6:16-17, during the Seventh Seal!m

12. Cry. Broadcast the message of Hope, (the **full** gospel of the Kingdom of God) that Jesus Christ will return, rescue the remnant of His people, and establish His Kingdom here, on the earth.

13. Shout. A powerful (TV?) message aimed primarily at Jacob and Judah.

14. His arm. This time, Christ returns as an awesome glowing and powerful figure, accompanied by His divine Bride, with whom He will **share rule on the earth!**

15. Isaiah 51:9. *Awake* from your slumber, Matthew 25:5, God's servants: act with courage upon God's words, as the active arm of the Lord, as did the prophets of old!

16. *Awake, Awake!* Again we are commanded to awaken from our spiritual deep sleep (eg. Mark 7:8, Leviticus 23:10-11) and immerse ourselves in Gods strength, character, and example, as revealed by His words, and we accept His challenge to prepare *for our coming role* in Jerusalem as witnesses (Isaiah 43:10) to the future captive nations of Israel, then held in slavery!

17. To Zion. How rewarding it will be to bring good news to those of Jacob and Judah about to give up all hope; that their God is coming to rescue them. Those faithful watchmen will eventually see His final return with their own eyes, NIV, as they will return from Heaven together with Christ!

18. God's faithful watchmen deliver this message of a glorious future where peace, safety and prosperity flourish under the rule of the Almighty, for most of the first half of the 7 year Tribulation. They finally return from the sea of glass in Heaven with Him at the end of the last half of the Tribulation, the 7^{th} Seal.

19. Then the wise. (Who came to Jerusalem to deliver this message at God's Command, Jeremiah 31) will glow as did Moses after being with the Almighty on Sinai, for they are then part of the family of God.

20. Man dressed in linen. An angel.

21. All these things take place until the halfway point in the last 7 years, Daniel 9:27, and 12:7, Revelation 12:14, until their sacrificial work in Jerusalem is completed, when they flee, Matthew 24:16, and their rescue and Resurrection occurs, Zechariah 9:14-16.

Note on Isaiah 56:9-10, Ezekiel 34:10.

We cannot believe that there are no exceptions to these words, for if that were so, God's message would not be broadcast from Jerusalem and we read it is, but obviously God is referring to the majority of His ministers whom He has deluded, (2 Thessalonians 2:10-11) maybe to the extent that they can read over those End-Time commands without them even registering?
